Application for Funding





What is the Okefenoke Rural Electric Membership Corporation Foundation, Inc.?

The Foundation has been established as a 501(c)(3) charitable organization. It is a community development initiative currently funded by OREMC unclaimed capital credits and other donations that may be received.

Who is eligible for funding?

Funds are available for organizations/agencies who provide services to people living within the Okefenoke REMC eight-county service area: Brantley, Camden, Charlton, Glynn, Ware and Wayne counties in Georgia; Baker and Nassau counties in Florida. Organizations are only allowed to apply for funds once within a 12-month period.

How can an organization/agency apply for funding?

Applications are accepted by mail or by dropping off at one of our district offices. Applications received after the quarterly deadline will be held until the next meeting of the Foundation's board of trustees. Incomplete applications will not be considered or kept on file. Repeat applicants must submit a new application with each funding request.

What is the selection process?

Funds are administered by nine volunteers of the Okefenoke Rural Electric Membership Corporation Foundation, Inc., Board of Directors who represent the geographic areas where Okefenoke REMC provides electric service. The decisions made by the Foundation Board are based on the amount of funding available and the needs presented. Preference will be given to applicants that provide evidence funds will remain in the Okefenoke REMC service area. All applicants will be notified of the results within 30 days of the board's decision.

What types of programs/needs are eligible for funding?

- Community Service related to overall quality of life with emphasis on public safety, health care, self-sufficiency and basic human needs.
- Education & Youth initiatives that promote scholarship, leadership, wellness/physical fitness and combat social problems such as literacy, emotional development and counseling.
- Disaster Relief projects providing food, clothing, shelter, medical care, clean-up repairs and reconstruction in an emergency following an accident, severe storm or other events.
